Share.	<b>7.</b> Ask for feedback from students. See how the class is going or their semester overall.	8 Encourage help seeking behaviors, use SOS or encourage students to use SOS.
9 Review the outstanding resources created by OIA.	10 Encourage connections in the classroom. Help students connect with each other so they can ask each other questions or create community.	11. Create a positive class experience through affirming language and actions.	12. Create personal connections by learning and using student's names.
